EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Karen Mason, Executive Director, presented the following for the Board's information:

1. Regarding correspondence received from David A. Cook, Interim Executive Director, Medical Association of Georgia concerning support that Medical Directors, who engage in making decisions related to medical necessity are regulated by the Board. The Board accepted this as Information Only.
2. Regarding correspondence received from Ann Beach, M.D. concerning visiting professors/physicians who come to give lectures and consult on patients to operate on a patient would they have to get a Georgia license or is there a teaching license that would apply. Dr. Cheeks moved to refer to the AG's office for advice on statutes concerning teaching license status, Dr. Wiltz seconded and it carried unanimously.
3. Regarding correspondence from the Federation of State Medical Boards concerning the call for nominations and appointment recommendations. The Board accepted this as Information Only.
4. Regarding correspondence from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services that allows State Governors to determine whether Nurse Anesthetists need supervision. The Board accepted this as Information Only.

The Board decided to notify Dr. Gillespie that the Board has no authority to regulate medical malpractice liability.

7. Regarding correspondence from The University of Tennessee concerning residents in Tennessee being granted exemption from license requirements for one-month rotations in Georgia. Dr. Woolery moved to recommend that these residents be required to apply for a license in Georgia, Dr. Cheeks seconded and it carried unanimously.

Wray, Senior Assistant Attorney General, was present and represented the State. A court reporter was present to record the proceedings.

The Hearing Officer announced that there was a request by the respondent to review the initial decision delivered by the Administrative Law Judge. Mr. Kleckley requested to present additional testimony to the Board. The Board voted to accept the additional testimony. Dr. Swicord was sworn in and delivered his oral arguments. Mrs. Wray delivered her oral arguments. After oral arguments, Board Members asked questions of the Respondent. After oral arguments and questionings, the review ended, and the Hearing Officer, Respondent and his attorney, Mrs. Wray, Board staff, the court reporter and all other parties left the meeting while the Board members deliberated in Executive Session.
