Prescribing drugs for a patient on a repeated basis or for greater than a 48-hour supply based solely on a consultation with the patient, patient's guardian or patient's agent via electronic means.

Physician's Assistants may not prescribe drugs or other treatments for patients that they have not personally examined.”
